

AGREEMENT:

2017 Old Testament Full Scholarship

In 2017, every student who enters the Old Testament course of the online program will be provided a full scholarship for that course.

Certain restrictions and guidelines do apply. This scholarship is only available to students taking the Old Testament course as his or her first course in the program.

Such student must agree to the following: An academic plan for the completion of all eight courses in the program through CUEnet must be submitted after completion of the Old Testament course, and the student must agree to persist through the program.

Exceptions to these requirements will be made only in extreme cases and only by formal appeal to the Director of Colloquy.

Failure to meet these two requirements will result in an invoice being sent to the student for full tuition of the Old Testament course.

Scholarships will be available on a first-come, first-served basis until the grant funds are depleted, or until December 2017, whichever comes first.

I have read the expectations of the scholarship as stated above and agree to abide by them. I acknowledge that if I cannot abide by them, I will be invoiced for the full tuition of the Old Testament course.
